

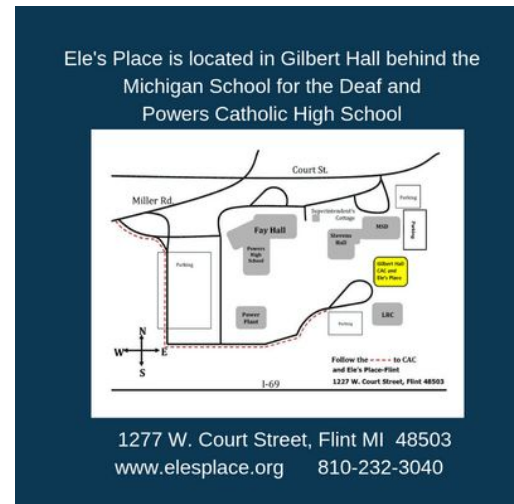
Junior League of Flint Bus Tour on Tuesday, September 17, 2019 from 5-8pm

Directions

Ele's Place of Greater Flint and Genesee County is located on the campus of the Michigan School for the Deaf however our building is accessed through the Powers HS parking lot. It can be very confusing over here because many of the drives are one-way and/or are blocked off to through traffic. You will want to enter the campus from the drive closest to Hammerberg Rd. This drive is right in front of the Softball and Baseball fields and the sign indicates "MSD Bus Loop." If you enter here you can follow this map to find your way to Gilbert Hall. We share this building with the Communication Access Center who occupies the first floor and we have the second floor.

Donations

Our Done in a Meeting/Done in a Day (DIAM/DIAD) for September is to bring donations for Ele's Place, Voices for Children Advocacy Center and Shelter of Flint during our bus tour. They have requested the following items:

Ele's Place

- Potluck supplies (plates, forks/knives/spoons, napkins, cups)
- Antibacterial wipes,
- Art supplies (crayons, markers, stickers for scrapbooks, glue sticks and tacky glue) or
- Gift cards (Michaels, Hobby Lobby, Walmart, Dollar Tree)

Voices for Children Advocacy Center

- Individually wrapped snacks for the children (hot cheetos, chips, granola bars, cookies, juice boxes, etc.)

Shelter of Flint

- Personal hygiene items for women, men, and children (deodorant; body wash/soap; shampoo and conditioner for all hair types; toothpaste; toothbrushes)
- Individual serving size food items for our homeless outreach team (please, nothing that requires a can opener or scissors to open)
- Travel size (hotel size) hygiene products
- Household cleaning supplies and paper products
